Summary

The City of Alachua Commission has engaged the services of Brame Architects of Gainesville, Florida to develop a basic design and plan to bring the "Swick House" at 15010 NW 142nd Terrace to full ADA compliance for use as a public facility.

The work scope will develop a facility with five meeting rooms, four accessible and one non accessible restroom and open patio space. Two of the accessible restrooms are designed for access from the exterior of the building and are to serve outside activity participants.

The project received funding approval through the City's Downtown Redevelopment Trust Fund by the Downtown Redevelopment Trust Board during its June 19, 2013 meeting. This presentation will offer an update to this Board.
