

RESOLUTION 23-11

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF ALACHUA, FLORIDA; AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2022-2023 BUDGET FOR THE RECEIPT OF UNANTICIPATED REVENUE; INCREASING THE GENERAL FUND PUBLIC WORKS BUDGET TO APPROPRIATE REVENUES AND EXPENSES RELATED TO THE SETTLEMENT WITH HARVEST DCP OF FLORIDA, LLC; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, City of Alachua entered into a settlement agreement with Harvest DCP of Florida, LLC on February 13, 2023; and,

WHEREAS, pursuant to said agreement, the payment has been received in the amount of one million, eight hundred fifty-one thousand, seven hundred forty and 40/100 dollars (\$1,851,740.40);

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF ALACHUA COMMISSION:

- 1. The Finance and Administrative Services Director is directed to amend the Fiscal Year 2022-2023 Budget by increasing the General Fund and appropriating the amount of one million, eight hundred fifty-one thousand, seven hundred forty-one dollars (\$1,851,741.00) as reflected in the budget amendment attached hereto as Exhibit A.
- 2. That this resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
