

GENERAL NOTES FOR DRIVEWAY CONNECTIONS:

- 1. EACH PROPERTY HAS THE RIGHT TO MAKE ONE DRIVEWAY CONNECTION TO AN ADJACENT CITY ROAD UNLESS A SAFETY ISSUE MAKES THE CONNECTION DANGEROUS TO THE PROPERTY OWNERS OR ROADWAY USERS.
- 2. JOINT USE DRIVEWAYS ARE ENCOURAGED.
- 3. A ONE-WAY-IN CONNECTION AND A ONE-WAY-OUT CONNECTION COUNT AS ONE DRIVEWAY CONNECTION. THE SEPARATION OF THE "IN" AND "OUT" DRIVEWAYS SHALL BE DICTATED BY SAFETY CONSIDERATIONS, BUT SHALL NOT BE LESS THAN 20 FEET.
- 4. DRIVEWAY CONNECTIONS SHALL ADHERE TO FDOT CHAPTER 14-97 ACCESS MANAGEMENT CLASSIFICATION SYSTEM AND STANDARDS.
- 5. TWO DRIVEWAY CONNECTIONS MAY BE CONSIDERED, CONDITIONS PERMITTING, AND IF THE CONNECTIONS MEET FDOT ACCESS STANDARDS.
